in addition he reported receipts of \$35,754 and expenditures of \$35,557 on his personal account in the nomination campaign.

Both Landon and Knox reported the Republican national committee is financing their general election campaigns.

Reports of other presidential and vice-presidential candidates follow: William Lemke, union party, no personal receipts or expenditures, but \$5,321 received by the party in his own behalf and \$2,390 expended for him.

John W. Aiken, socialist-labor party presidential candidate and Emil F. Teichert, vice presidential nominee of the same party reported no personal receipts or expenditures.

A similar report was filed by Dr. D. Leigh Colvin, prohibition party presidential nominee and his running mate, Claude D. Watson.

Earl Browder, presidential nominee of the communist party, listed personal receipts of \$1,112 and expenditures of \$1,041.

Browder spent \$1,061. Norman Thomas, socialist candidate for president, reported receipts of \$5,441 and expenditures of \$6,504. Thomas' receipts and expenditures were listed as those of the party.

Total receipts of \$419,282 and expenditures of \$461,852 since January 1 were reported today to the clerk of the house by national headquarters of the American Liberty league. The report covered transactions to October 19.

The largest contribution was \$35,000 from the United Mine Workers of America. Other unions donated \$100 to \$1,000.
