

# AL SMITH LASHES NEW DEAL COSTS; HECKLER OUSTED

## Tells Audience At Chicago How Long It Requires To Get Billion At \$1 a Minute— Heckler Is Ejected.

CIVIC OPERA HOUSE, Chicago,  
Oct. 23.—(UP)—Alfred E. Smith lashed out at the New Deal administration last night as having abandoned "the fundamental principles" of the democratic party.

He spoke before 3600 cheering enthusiasts of Jeffersonian democracy in his third campaign attack on the Roosevelt administration.

"I want to talk about a billion dollars," he announced.

"If you were to put away a dollar every minute since Christ died on Calvary, you'd only have a billion dollars and I want to show tonight how little the New Deal thinks of a billion dollars."

**Gives Statistics**

"Suppose you wanted to know how long it would take to pay the debt of the administration. You know how long it'd take to pay a billion dollars. Well, the government debt now is 34 billion. If you were to pay it back at the rate of a dollar a minute, well, it'd take 65,000 years."

"Well, who owes it? We do. Who's going to pay it? We are. When I hear this talk about soaking the rich I know that if you took everything from the rich, including their undershirt you couldn't pay any part of it."

A heckler, waving an American flag, advanced to the front of the audience early during the talk and shouted unintelligibly at Smith. He became red in the face as he accused Smith of "talking against our president."

### IRRIGATION FEUD ENDS IN MURDER

BOISE, Idaho, Oct. 23.—(UP)—A 12-year-old feud over irrigation rights climaxed yesterday when L. C. Snell, 65, of Boise, was shot and killed by his neighbor, Bert Means, 55, also of Boise.

Ada County Prosecutor Willis Motlat said that he would hold Means under murder charges, pending the findings of a coroner's jury.

County Coroner J. J. McCann said he had not determined when he would call a jury for an inquest. Claiming self defense, Means told Sheriff Earl Coleman that he had been working in his back yard when Snell and his son came out and "began cursing me."

He said Snell took three shots at him, one of them taking effect in his neck.

"Then I went into the house," Means said, "and got a .38 caliber pistol."

He came out with the weapon and shot Snell through the heart, police said.

CORVALLIS, Oct. 23.—(AP)—The "Hort" show, revived as an annual event at Oregon State college two years ago, will be held Friday and Saturday, October 30 and 31, by the members of the Horticultural club.

### Probe Is Started By Severed Leg

DENVER, Colo., Oct. 23.—(UP)—Lists of persons recently reported missing in Colorado and New Mexico were being combined today as police sought clues to the identity of a young woman or child whose amputated leg was found near Trinidad, Colo., yesterday by a shepherd dog.

The leg, severed skillfully with a knife and saw seven inches above the knee and wrapped in a newspaper dated Oct. 19, apparently had been thrown from a moving automobile.
