For the first nine months of this year, however, imports exceeded exports by \$33,156,000, compared with a \$66,496,000 excess of exports for the corresponding 1935 period.

Approximately two-thirds of the export increase in September over the same month a year ago, the department said, was due to large shipments of unmanufactured cotton, machinery and vehicles.

During September, exports totaled \$219,967,000 compared with \$198,803,000 for the same month a year ago.

Imports last month were \$215,525,000 compared with \$161,647,000 in September, 1935.

For the first nine months of this year, exports were listed as \$1,732,314,000 compared with \$1,568,371,000 in the corresponding 1935 period.

Discussing factors in the export increase, the department said unmanufactured cotton shipments increased from \$31,817,000 in September, 1935, to \$38,221,000 last month.

Exports of industrial machinery increased from \$9,228,000 to \$12,298,000 and shipments of agricultural machinery from \$2,713,000 to \$3,806,000.

"Among other commodities to be exported in larger volume than in September of last year," the department said, "were lead, dairy products, fish, grains, dried fruits, rubber manufactures, tobacco manufactures, sawmill products, copper, coal-tar products and medicinal preparations."

Decreases were listed in exports of apples, canned fruits, leaf tobacco and refined petroleum products.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 29.—(AP)—The commerce department reported today that United States exports exceeded imports by \$4,442,000 during September.

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
