Conceived in plot by the president of the United States, Franklin D. Roosevelt, "The President's Mystery" heads the double feature program opening a three day run at the Rialto theatre today. The second feature, "The Big Game" is, as the title implies, a football story.

"Can a man, who has achieved great wealth, disappear completely in an attempt to get away from it all?" was the idea which the president advanced as the basis for the story. Liberty Magazine assigned the task of developing the idea to six famous authors — John Erskine, Rupert Hughes, Anthony Abbot, S. S. Van Dine and Samuel Hopkins Adams. The results of their combined labors made the story one of the most popular the magazine ever published.

The president's hero, too, has an ambition. In his new identity, he strives to make a poor, workless community live again and its people to prosper. Further drama is brought into the picture when the man's faithless wife is discovered murdered at the time of his own disappearance, with events moving rapidly to a climax when his true identity is learned after he has put the town "on its feet."
