BIDS RUN HIGH FOR TULE LAKE LAND USE

KLAMATH FALLS, Nov. 11.—(AP)—Lease bids accepted by the bureau of reclamation for 48,000 acres of government land on the west side of fertile Tule lake will boost the rentals paid during 1937 to more than double the amount paid during the past lease year.

Excitement ran high at the bidding opening here yesterday, with a record number of bidders seeking to gain temporary possession of the land which during the past five years has returned profits to its tenants running into hundreds of thousands of dollars.

YOUTH KILLS FARMER TO GAIN ANCIENT CAR

ADRIAN, Mich., Nov. 11.—(P)—A 16-year-old farm boy faced trial today on first degree murder charges after confession he ambushed and killed a farmer to steal a six-year-old automobile.

Assistant Prosecutor Lawrence J. Hammond said Elmer Dillon, a short, stocky youth clad in overalls, had admitted that he lay in wait for nearly two hours before shooting down 63-year-old Melvin Whaley as the farmer alighted from his car to do his milking at a farm near Canandaigua, Mich. last night.

Dillon fled in Whaley's 1930 model automobile and wrecked the car in a ditch near Morend, Mich.

CANADIANS INCREASE CIGARETTE SMOKING

OTTAWA, Ont. (UP)—Consumption of cigarettes in Canada has increased by a billion since women and girls began smoking.

Government statistics just issued here show the consumption increased from 4,401,000,000 cigarettes in 1930 to 5,310,000,000 in 1935, and figures for this year indicate that it is still rising steadily.

The heavy increase in cigarette consumption is credited to the vogue of feminine smoking.

Cigar smoking, on the other hand, is declining. Five years ago 152,159,000 cigars were consumed. Last year consumption declined to 124,970,000.

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 11.—(P)—Mrs. Oliver Hardy is another of the wives of screen comedians who think, or have thought, their husbands not funny in their presence.

Mrs. Hardy disclosed her sentiments in a suit for separate maintenance on file today against the round-faced former Georgia vaudeville actor whose earnings, she claims, now are \$9,300 a week.

Hardy thus joins a long line of screen laugh-makers who have been unable to make their wives see continually the funny side of things. In the list is his own partner, Stan Laurel, who now faces two separate maintenance suits, one from his wife

and the other from a woman who claims she is his common-law wife. Hardy was described as "grouchy and ugly" in his attitude toward his wife, in the separate maintenance suit. She accused him of drinking, gambling and associating with other women, and of once causing her to be confined in a sanitarium against her will.

While she was in the sanitarium, she charged, Hardy caused rumors to be circulated that he had bought "a certain young woman" a home in Westwood and had created a \$12,000 trust fund for her.
