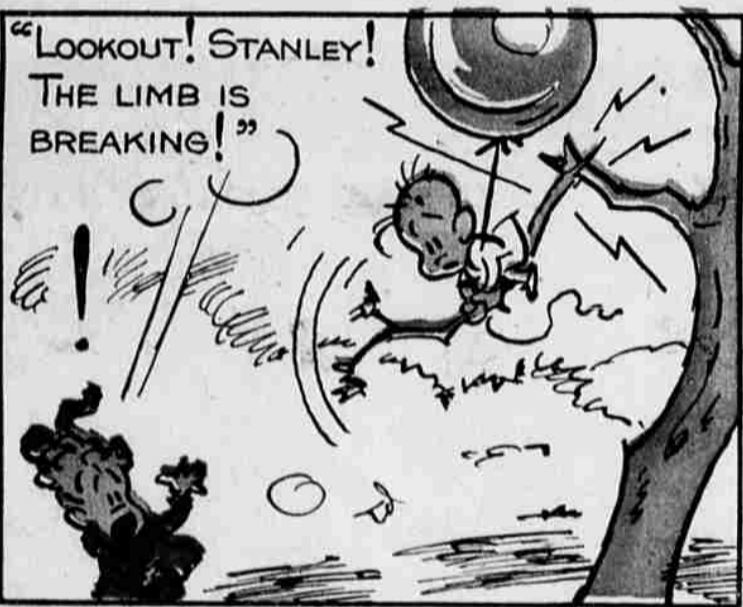

"LOOKOUT! STANLEY! THE LIMB IS BREAKING!"



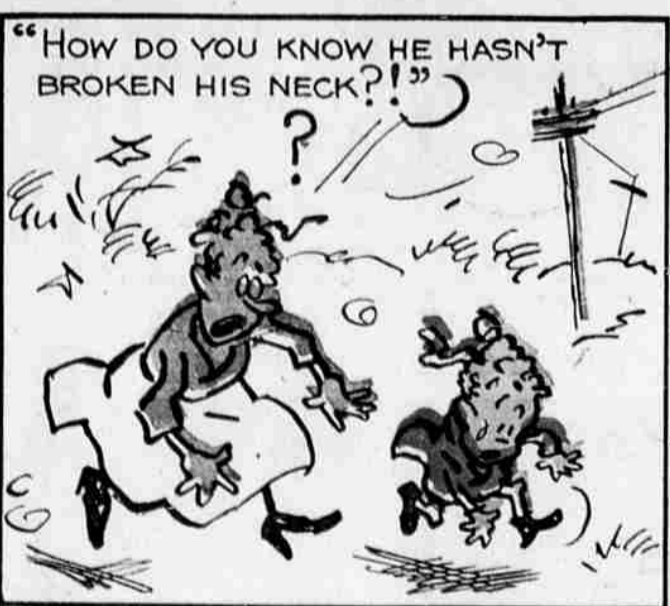
