IT was shortly after the turn of the present century. The present writer was, with several of his class mates, supping in grand opera in Boston.

THE "grand old lady" of grand opera, stage and screen, died last night, five years over the allotted span of three-score and ten.

Imagine a Melba, a Gadeki, a Farrar, in a similar situation, observing a sap-headed sup about to stumble into a scene.

NO, Schumann-Heink was never a prima donna, in fact, or in temperament, a contralto seldom takes the leading role.

IN short she was a GREAT woman,—a wonderful character,—and represented a type which in our world today, is becoming all too rare.

BUT it was more than absence of pulchritude, that accounted for the wholesomeness, simplicity and rectitude of her life behind the footlights.

THIS truth was most clearly brought out during the World war, when speaking broken English herself Schumann-Heink had sons in both the American and German armies.

AND it's in that role, that we would leave Mme. Ernestine Schumann-Heink, not as Ortd in Lohengrin, or Erda in "Die Walkure"—great as those roles were,—but just as a German American mother, offering her sons willingly to her two countries, and stretching out her big arms, over land and sea, to cheer and to protect them!
