Old Victory Bell Rung By Middies Left At School

ANNAPOLIS, Md., Nov. 28.—(AP)—Seven midshipmen, the only ones left on duty in Bancroft hall when the Naval Academy regiment went to Philadelphia, began celebrating Navy's victory over Army within a few seconds after the service classic ended today.

They made a dash for the old Japanese bell that is rung only when Navy downs Army on the gridiron, and began ringing it with a mallet. The victory bell will sound continuously until the football team returns to the academy at 5:30 p. m. tomorrow.

It was the second time in 15 years that the bell has sounded.

CHICAGO, Nov. 28.—(AP)—Throne chairs began to fill tonight at the International Livestock exposition and International Grain and Hay show.

Most familiar figure to ascend the heights of grand championships was Herman Trelle of Wembley, Alta., Canada, who exhibited the grand championship oats for his 15th purple ribbon. The Peace River valley farmer showed the "Victory" variety.

An Illinois farm boy, Robert Vaughn of Chenoa, Ill., led a 1,250-pound Aberdeen Angus steer into the spotlight as the grand champion 4-H steer of the show and the animal became a contestant for the title of grand champion steer. Vaughn calls his steer "Whizbang."

F. Mommens of Miles, Iowa, brought the grand champion carlet of steers, also Aberdeen-Anguses, to the show. The champion sample of field beans was exhibited by Albert C. Gohn of Emo, Ont., Canada, a variety known as "Gohn's Hairy River."

C. J. Brodie of Stouffville, Ont., Canada, shipped the champion carload of lamb, a native breed under 55 pounds.

Farm youth led off in meat animal competition as the big show of farm-dome, the 37th international exposition, got under way.

Junior livestock raisers were first to have their names on the winner's sheets as their elders prepared entries for competition in the world's largest agricultural show.

Warren Field of Hinton, Iowa, took first blue ribbon with a Shorthorn steer in the light class.
