BIG DOPE SHIPMENT SEIZED IN PORTLAND

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 3.—(AP)—United States customs agents confiscated seven and a half pounds of illicit narcotics and arrested Yee Sing, Chinese, to complete one of Portland's largest seizures in recent years. C. A. Emerick, customs agent, said the shipment came to Portland from New York, where it probably was smuggled into the United States from Europe. Officers were aware the package contained narcotics when it arrived Friday and Sing was taken yesterday when he called for it. Wholesale price of the drug was estimated at \$1500 but in the hands of dope peddlers the 49,000 grains could be sold at \$2 a grain for \$98,000.
