Damages Sought

The following letter from Attorney Allison Moulton was read to the council and referred to City Attorney Frank P. Farrell:

\$50,000 Required Now

"The above plan would provide a fund of \$50,000 to start with and thereafter ten or twelve thousand dollars a year for the purpose of repair of streets. We estimate that the total cost of street repairs will be in excess of \$100,000."
