CANNERY WORKERS TO GET MORE PAY

SALEM, April 22.—(AP)—Oregon cannery employes will receive a 20 percent increase in the minimum hourly wage at 35 cents for women and 45 cents for men, Gram said, despite the increase "we have been assured of the cooperation of the canning industry as a whole."

Gram stated the welfare commission was not unmindful of the additional competitive handicap to Oregon canners, but it felt the wage increase was justified by increased living costs.

The new minimum wage rate for women is about 30 percent higher than ever before fixed in Oregon for the industry, including the year 1929, the labor commissioner declared. Oregon pays a higher cannery wage than any other state in the union with the exception of California.

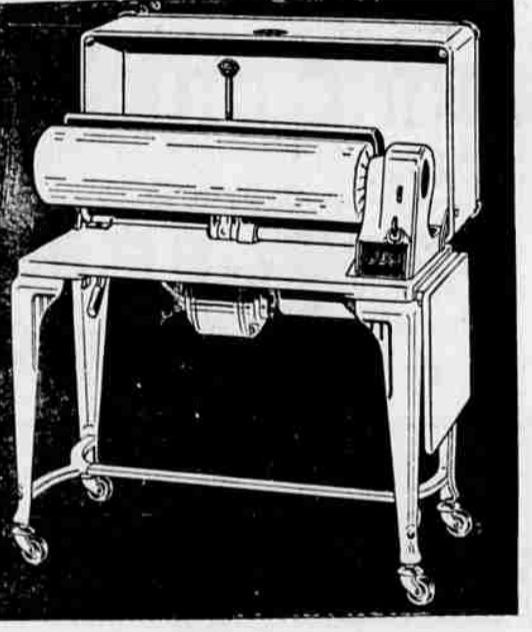

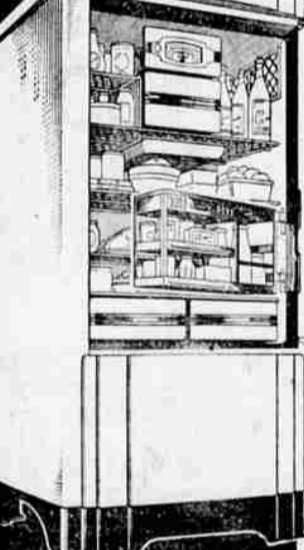
