

### 350 EIGHTH GRADE GRADUATES TO GET DIPLOMAS FRIDAY

Dean Duback of Oregon State College to Give Address at Annual School Day at Ashland Tomorrow

Between 900 and 350 eighth grade graduates of Jackson county schools will attend graduation exercises at the sixteenth annual Jackson county school day to be held in Ashland tomorrow.

Dean U. G. Duback of Oregon State college will deliver the principal address. The exercises will be held from 10 a. m. until noon in the Ashland Junior high school.
