

FRANCO'S TROOPS PUSH OFFENSIVE TO BILBOA'S EDGE

Basque's Plan to Blast City to Prevent Capture by Advancing Rebels.

(By the Associated Press.)

Insurgent General Francisco Franco's legions pushed a broad offensive to the edge of Bilbao today, occupying the international airfield and climbing the last two hills at the western entrance to the Basque capital.

Slowly they closed the last gaps in their plan of encirclement and mapped a new drive on Santander, 45 miles west of Bilbao.

Indications were the march on Santander would begin at nightfall should Franco's soldiers succeed in bottling up Bilbao and occupying that city by that time.

There were rumors the Basques and their Asturian allies were planning to dynamite the rich industrial capital rather than let it fall into the hands of the insurgents.

Insurgent shock troops, fully equipped to cope with Basques in last-stand street fighting, massed at the outskirts of Bilbao, ready for a quick assault to "save" the city from such destruction.

Advices reaching Hendaye on the Franco-Spanish border said Franco's forces had crossed the Nervion river both north and south of Bilbao.

Insurgents also were reported to have captured three government boatloads of 3,000 refugees fleeing the beleaguered city.

In London, the European non-intervention committee called a session for Friday to again consider an appeal to both sides in the Spanish civil conflict to refrain from aerial bombardment of open cities.

General Franco's attempt completely to unify the forces under him brought a death sentence for Manuel Hedilla, former leader of the fascist pbalanz, and 14 others.

PAY BOOST CUTS WORKERS NUMBER

PORTLAND, June 17.—(P)—Enforcement of an arbitration board award providing increases in salaries for employees of the Portland Traction company forced drastic retrenchment including the laying off of a number of employees. William H. Lines, vice president and general manager of the company said.

The award which provided a 15 per cent wage boost for platform employees and gave salaried workers a \$5 increase will cost the company approximately \$350,000 annually, Lines said.

FEDERAL BUTTER GRADING CHANGE IS VERY SLIGHT

PORTLAND, June 17.—(AP)—Federal standards of butter grading will not be materially changed in proposed revisions. C. W. Kitchen of the bureau of agricultural economics said at a hearing here Wednesday, attended by creamery and Oregon State college and state officials.

Among the proposed changes he listed the elimination of the package as a factor in grading and substitution of a more direct method for the present score-card plan of evaluating grading factors.

The new method, he said, would provide a range of from 75 to 95 instead of from 84 to 95 as at present.

He pointed out that under the commodities exchange act deliveries of butter on future contracts shall conform to standards set up by the secretary of agriculture.

Butter Cargoes Higher DULUTH, Minn. (UP)—Shipments of butter by water from Duluth to lower lake ports are expected to reach a total value of approximately \$50,000,000 this year, according to upper lake shippers. Between 70,000

and 75,000 tons of butter will be loaded in Duluth this season as compared to 69,730 tons during the 1936 shipping season.

Statue To Honor Cow WOODSTOCK, Ont. (UP)—A five-ton statue is being erected on a farm here in honor of a cow. The memorial, a life-sized metal statue of a cow, will be unveiled in honor of "Springbank Snow Countess," world's greatest lifetime producer of butter-fat.
