So little was left to be done that veteran observers and legislators wondered why the leaders did not wrap up the session tonight. Not for many years has there been so little major legislation in the mill at a session's close. It happened this time only because most of the controversial problems were postponed until the next session. House acceptance of a revamped sugar control bill sent the controversial legislation to the White House to an uncertain fate. Ditched in the rush to adjourn were not only the wage-hour and farm bills, but a crop insurance measure and a host of less important bills.
