VANDALIA, O., Aug. 24.—(P)—Joe Hiestand of Hillsboro, O. surrendered today the North American clay target championship which he had held for two years when he missed four targets of the first 100 in the 200-target race for the 1937 crown.

Mrs. Lela Hall of Strauberg, Mo., winner of the women's championship the last two years, hit the half-way mark with 98 of 100, after breaking the first 75 straight, and was a definite threat to become the first woman in history to win the title three times.

JAPANESE MORALE DUE FOR COLLAPSE UNLESS WAR WITH CHINA WON

MANILA, P. I., Aug. 24.—(AP)—Japan is threatened with economic and moral collapse from her unofficial war on China, in the opinion of Carl Crow, Shanghai advertising executive.

Crow arrived yesterday on the refugee liner President Hoover en route to Fort Worth, Tex., and New York City. "A new China is lined up against Japan," he said. "It is a nation with a high morale which has been preparing for a reckoning with Japan for the last five years."
