

# Deanna Durbin, Menjou In Craterian's Musical Comedy-Drama

STOKOWSKI, ALICE BRADY AND EUGENE PALLETTE IN CAST

Deanna Durbin America's new 14-year old sweetheart who rose to fame in "Three Smart Girls," is starred in her second picture, "100 Men and a Girl," a comedy drama with music which opens a three-day run at the New Craterian theatre today. Featured with Deanna Durbin is Leopold Stokowski, famous conductor of the Philadelphia Symphony.

An unusual cast surrounds Deanna. Adolphe Menjou is seen as her father, a musician who, with 100 fellow artists, seeks recognition of talent and a chance for a livelihood. Alice Brady portrays a society matron who promises Deanna to sponsor the orchestra. Then the rich woman flounces off to Europe and leaves Menjou and Deanna in the lurch.

Eugene Palette, as Alice Brady's husband, has the situation placed squarely before him on his shiny mahogany desk by Deanna Durbin. Her eloquent statement of the 100 men's dilemma causes him to agree to sponsor the orchestra, providing Stokowski will conduct it. Nothing daunted, Deanna goes to Stokowski. She charms him first with her singing. He agrees to hear the orchestra and finds they are excellent musicians. Then the story sweeps to its climax, carrying human drama, delightful comedy and memorable music to a rhythmic crest. Stokowski has devised a new method of recording music which gives the effect of sound in perspective.

Deanna treats the world with the songs millions of fans have waited to hear her sing among them are: "A Heart That's Free," "It's Raining Sunbeams" and other famous arias.

Also included in the cast are Billy Gilbert, Jack Smart, Alma Kruger and Jed Prouty.

**BENNETT IS SUED FOR ALLEGED RAID DAMAGE**

PORTLAND, Ore., Sept. 18.—(UP)—Portland's militant city commissioner, J. E. Bennett, who personally led several raids on what he termed "Chinese gambling joints" was today the defendant in a \$1000 suit filed by Larry Chin, Chinese, for alleged damage done to the front door of his residence in one of the raids.

The door was smashed when Bennett led a raid against the house to secure evidence in his one-man gambling probe. Chin charged Bennett "purposely, maliciously, deliberately and wantonly smashed in the plate-glass front door entrance to plaintiff's home." He asked \$37.50 for the door, \$3 damage done to laundry in the place, and \$950 for punitive damages.

The exclusive, authentic and official round-by-round Joe Louis vs. Tommy Farr fight pictures heads the big double bill program starting a three day run at the Rialto theatre today. The film which has been eagerly looked forward to by fight fans is, according to experts, one of the greatest and strangest pictures ever recorded of a championship bout. Slow motion and close-up shots show positions of the fighters during their heaviest struggles. Farr, a product of the Wales coal mines and just as tough as the rock he mined, is seen fighting his way through for 15 rounds of punishment at the hands of the Detroit Bomber, who was once himself an Alabama cotton picker.
