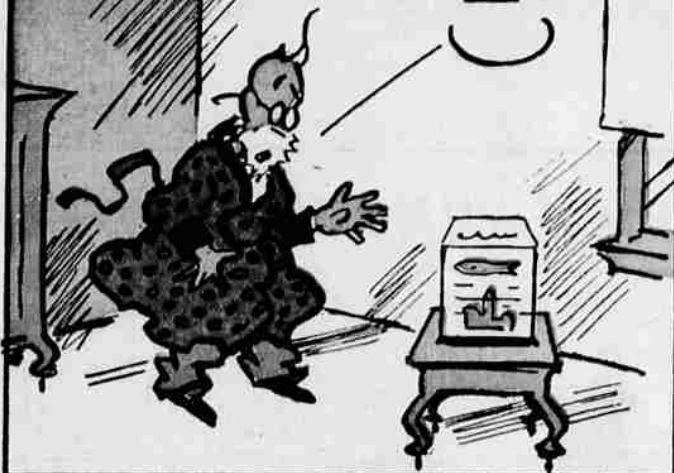

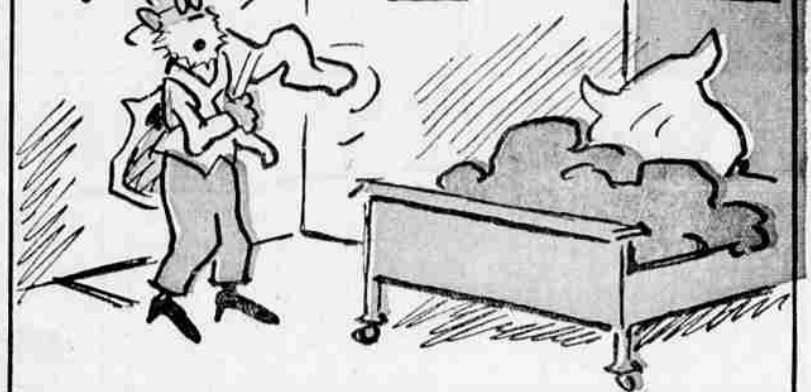
"OH, DEAR ME! I'VE LET EMMA'S FISH DIE!"

"I KNOW WHAT I'LL DO! I'LL MATCH THAT FISH JUST THE WAY YOU MATCH A PIECE OF SILK!"



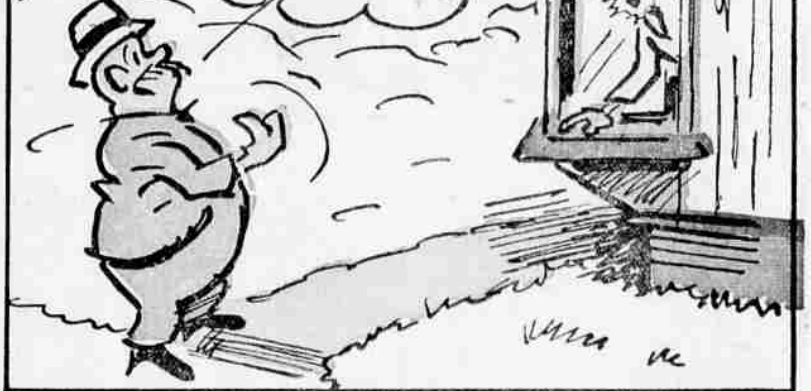

"HEY! PROFESSOR! MY WIFE'S AWAY, TOO! COME ON AND WE'LL EAT BREAKFAST TOGETHER!"



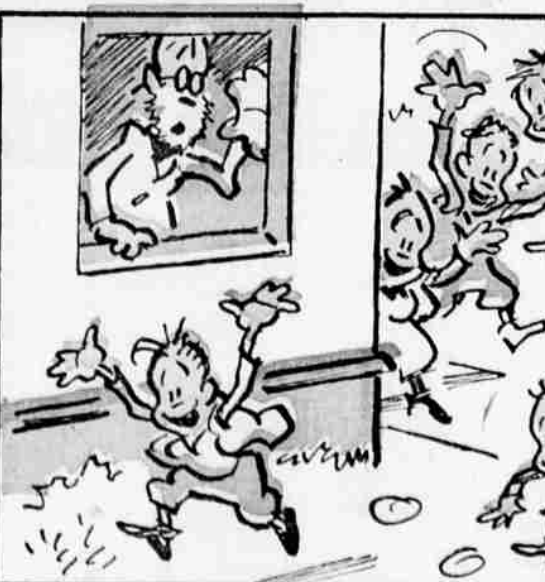
"CARRYIN' AROUND AN OLD CAN AND CAN'T REMEMBER WHAT FOR!"
