KLAMATH INDIAN HELD NOT GUILTY BY JURY ON ASSAULT CHARGE

Tiffany Hill, 37, Klamath reservation Indian, was found not guilty of assault with a dangerous weapon by a jury in United States district court last night. Hill was accused of assaulting his wife with a rifle on the reservation September 6. Testifying as the sole defense witness, Hill denied using the rifle. He declared he assaulted the woman with his fists and feet after she had tried to shoot him with the rifle. The jury was given the case at 3:40 p. m. yesterday and returned its verdict at 8:15 last night. Under court appointment, Attorney Otto J. Frohmayer represented the defendant. Manley B. Strayer, assistant United States attorney, prosecuted. The jury was composed of Lyle Lamphar of Grants Pass, foreman; Edward N. Baeye of Takilma, W. L. BUILDINGS TO RISE ON BANDO ASHES

BANDON, Oct. 12.—(AP)—Nearly \$100,000 worth of new buildings will grace Bandon's ashline in the near future. The city, destroyed by forest fires more than a year ago, will need a site to the government for a \$75,000 unit of the coast guard. The Baptist church has prepared the foundation for a \$3500 structure and the Methodist and Catholic congregations are making plans for buildings. A funeral home and a grade school are listed among the early building projects.
