T. Slater Johnston subscribes \$5 to fund to buy Christmas smokes for soldiers in France.

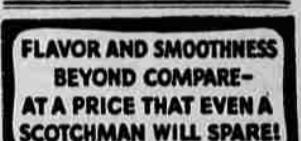
Home Economics club to be organized in county.

Here's news! A loyal New Dealer is being applauded by the legal profession for his proposed crusade in the cause of the business man against the dragon of bureaucracy. The crusading New Dealer is Senator Logan. Applause is still echoing from the convention of the American Bar association for the "administrative review" idea which the Kentucky solon plans to ask congress to enact into law.

Administrative review means granting a citizen or corporation the right of appeal to the courts if he feels he has been given unfair treatment by certain government commissions or agencies. For instance, if a radio station owner were denied a license, under the proposed law he might appeal to the district court of appeals. The same might be done with regard to a decision of the board of tax appeals, or any agency licensing a business.

When Senator Logan didn't appear at the convention to read his paper on administrative review, as scheduled, some of the cynics suggested his illness, offered as an excuse for his absence, was "diplomatic" since the bar meeting was anything but pro-New Deal. This wasn't the case. He expects, however, to be on deck for the special session, the calling of which he heartily approves.

One of the toughest jobs in Washington is held by a newcomer who doesn't get into print. But he gets into every discussion on what is about to be printed, if he can. He is the affable, ubiquitous representative of the Japanese official Domei news agency, Mr. Masuo Kato. Mr. Kato attended several American universities, holds that it is well to understand a foreign nation before you discuss its activities, and takes a lot of pretty rough talk with a bland smile. 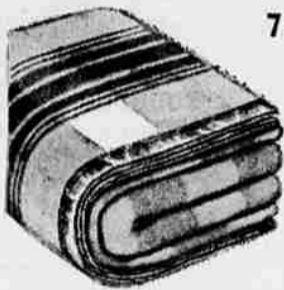
