

### MORMON LEADERS TRY TO SOCIALIZER MODERN DANCING

**SALT LAKE CITY**—In this "dancing city in America" the Church of Latter Day Saints has set out to socialize ballroom behavior.  
 "For a long time we have felt that modern dancing, limited almost exclusively to waltzes and fox trots, does not provide the opportunities for friendliness, poise and culture that were found in the more complex dances of older times," explains gray-haired W. O. Robinson, who has directed dance activities of the Mormons for 13 years and is leading the new movement.  
 Says Robinson: "Young people who dance with but one partner then sit in a corner for a while and hold hands, and then dance again are not cultivating the best principles of sociability. In a way, you see, modern dancing is really not social dancing at all."  
 He has designed three new dances—the Dream Waltz, Gold and Green Caprice (a swing square dance) and the Aloha One for trot. By December he expects they will be well established at church socials "and we believe their influence will spread beyond the church."

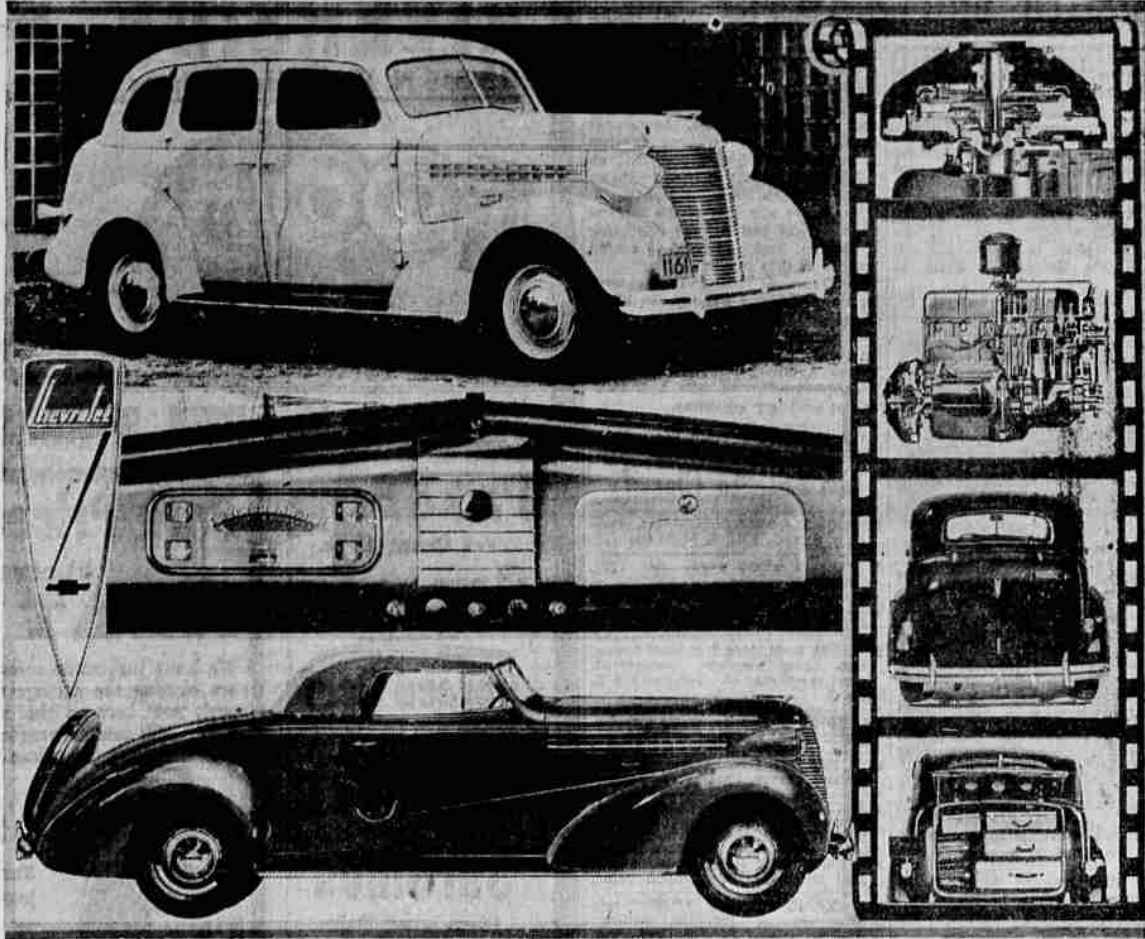

### MISSIONARIES GIVEN FIVE POINT PLAN IN FIGHT ON COMMUNISM

**VATICAN CITY, Oct. 22**—(AP)—A five-point program to guide Roman Catholic missionaries in their struggle against communism was laid down today by Monsignor Celso Costantini, former apostolic delegate to China and now secretary of the congregation for the propagation of the faith.  
 Monsignor Costantini addressing a large audience at the Pontifical Gregorian university, asserted that bolshevism "will kill itself with its own inhuman excesses."  
 The prelate, who is archbishop of Todi, outlined the church's five points for crushing bolshevism as follows:  
 1. A revival of the Christian sense of life among the faithful.  
 2. Instruction to the masses in "word, print and school."  
 3. Dynamic action to missionary action among non-Christians.  
 4. Continuous increase in the numbers of native clergy in order to "root the church on its natural."  
 5. Enlarged social assistance work.

**HUMANER WILL WAR ON BRUTALITY IN RODEOS**  
**PORTLAND, Oct. 22**—(AP)—Harry Daniel, president of the Oregon Humane society, set out today on a campaign to eliminate calf roping and bulldogging at next year's rodeos.  
 He described the events as "inhuman and brutal" and brought about by a "degenerated public" craving.

### MILK SAVES TWO FROM MONOXIDE

**PENDLETON, Ore., Oct. 22**—(AP) Joe Miller, service station owner at Mission near here, had heard that cold sweet milk administered to carbon-monoxide victims will bring them around in a hurry. Today he is satisfied with the method—at least it brought a woman and a child out of an unconscious condition.

Yesterday a family cluttered up to Miller's station in an ancient model car. The father, driving, was not affected by exhaust gas from the motor, which had rolled into the car but his wife and one child had lost consciousness. Two other children were made ill. A fourth suffered no ill effects.  
 The mother was unconscious for half an hour and the daughter for an hour, recovering, Miller said, after he had administered the milk.  
 Miller did not learn the name of the family, which was driving to La Grande from St. Marie's, Idaho.
