

CONFIDENCE LACK RECESSION CAUSE R.F.C. CHIEF SAYS

NEW YORK, Dec. 4.—(AP)—There is "no true basis for another depression," says Jesse H. Jones, chairman of the Reconstruction Finance Corporation.

"Notwithstanding the realities of these recessions or fears that have been multiplying in the minds of many people, we have not reached the stages of a depression," Jones said last night at the 52nd annual dinner of the New York Southern society.

While "we may be able to talk and think ourselves into a prolonged recession in business," he said, banks are "strong and buying with loanable funds," the average rate of wages is good, and "there is no lack of anything necessary to the general welfare except confidence, mutual confidence."

"In my opinion," he told the society, "the key to the situation confronting us today is intelligent, cordial, friendly, determined co-operation between government and business—government and all the people."

The RFC chairman said the budget could be balanced by the next fiscal year only "if we can get business started again and people back to work."

DUST LADEN HAZE OVER PITTSBURGH

PITTSBURGH, Dec. 4.—(AP)—Smoke-bound Pittsburghers sniffed and sneezed in a cold, dirt-laden haze today and hoped for a good stiff breeze.

Weather Observer W. S. Brotzman said the steel city was caught in the center of a slow-moving high-pressure area. Wind above the downtown section was moving about three miles an hour, he said, too feeble to blow away the accumulation of smoke and fog.

Airplane pilots reported the pillar of smoke rose a mile in the air and that the famed "Golden Triangle" resembled a "ball of black ink."

Automobile headlights failed to penetrate the haze and traffic became congested at a dozen intersections. Lights shone dully from office buildings in the weird, semi-daylight.

DOMINGO BORDER ATTACK CLAIMED

CIUDAD TRUJILLO, Dominican Republic, Dec. 4.—(AP)—The secretary of interior and police announced today that "a large number" of Dominican farmers had been killed or wounded in an attack by Haitians on a Dominican frontier community.

He said about 30 Haitian farmers armed with machetes attacked the town of Capotillo, near the border of the Dominican province of Monte Cristi. The raiders carried off livestock and farm produce, the minister declared.

Last month Haitian officials said between 3,000 and 5,000 Haitians had been killed by Dominican armed forces in troubles arising from wholesale expulsion of Haitian workers from the Dominican republic. Dominican said these charges were "fantastic."

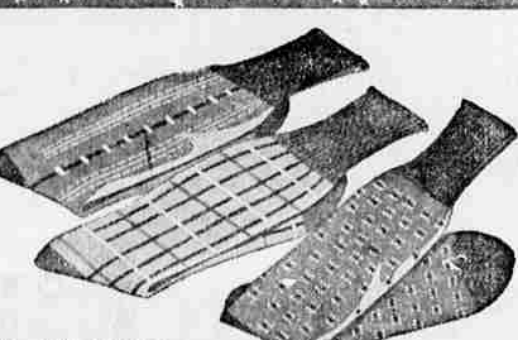

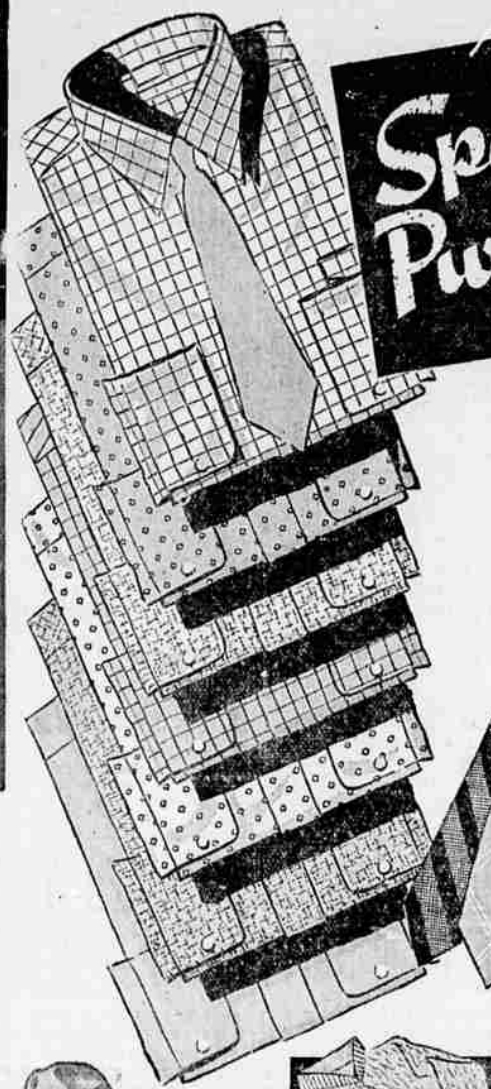

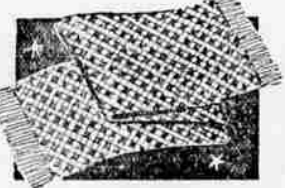
