WASHINGTON, April 23—(AP)—The administration geared down its credit inflation today, but adopted a program which will swell the lendable cash of the nation's banks to \$3,000,000,000 by the end of May.

Although it is theoretically possible for the treasury to pour its entire \$1,400,000,000 gold devaluation fund into the banks at once, Secretary Morgenthau decided that the initial trickle should be only \$50,000,000 per week.

The disbursement will be made by redeeming half of the \$100,000,000 worth of short-term treasury bills maturing each week for the next eight weeks, and by refunding the other half.

The caution with which the gold fund will be spent, officials indicated, was demonstrated by the fact that there should be any refunding at all, at a time when the treasury has all the cash it needs.

HIGHER EDUCATION ATTRACTS 10,000: EUGENE, April 23—(AP)—Accumulative enrollment at state supported institutions of higher learning in Oregon reached a total of more than 10,000 the present school year, it was announced today by Dr. F. M. Hunter, chancellor. The figure is a new record.

This number includes all students who have attended at any time during the year.

Actual attendance for the spring quarter totals 7,956 for all institutions, an increase of 7 per cent over last year and a gain of 50 per cent in the past five years.

Spring enrollment figures for the six institutions in the system are: University of Oregon, 2,867; Oregon State college, 8,732; Medical School and Nursing Education, 449; Oregon Normal school, 437; Southern Oregon Normal school, 203; Eastern Oregon Normal school, 167.
