WASHINGTON, April 26.—(AP)—A joint conference committee completed work today on a compromise draft of confining Senate and House tax revision bills. With differences between the two bills composed, Chairman Harrison (D-Mich.) of the Senate Finance committee said the compromise measure "is the most forward step in years toward helping employment by private initiative through a local policy of the federal government."
