

### CZECHS AROUSED BY NAZI FLIGHTS OVER TERRITORY

German Machine Sighted Above Great Skoda Munitions Plant Is Claim—Nations Prepare for Worst

(By the Associated Press) A Czechoslovakian government spokesman said tonight that a German warplane had been sighted on a flight over Czechoslovakia's great munitions plant, the Skoda factory, at Pilsen (Plzen).

The report cast a shadow over the prospects of a German-Czechoslovak settlement. The flight over Pilsen, some 50 miles from the German border in western Bohemia, was said by spokesmen to have been one of three border violations yesterday.

Meanwhile Czechoslovakia hoped for the best and prepared for the worst, maintaining a mobilization of arms on the German frontier, reminding householders to check preparations for air raids and providing gas masks for public employees on the installment plan.

Japan reshuffled her government today, strengthening it for a more vigorous war against China, while Britain proposed sending observers into the troubled Czechoslovak-German border region as a means of easing tension that had given Europe a jittery week.

Soviet Russia today blocked the way to agreement of the nine-power nonintervention subcommittee on the British plan to start withdrawal of foreign soldiers from the Spanish civil war.

After two tense sessions, Russia insisted that 10,000 men be withdrawn from each side, government and insurgent, as a "substantial" basis for granting belligerent rights to both sides.

In Spain, insurgent reinforcements were rushed to the Catalanian front to halt an ambitious government counter-offensive which insurgent commanders estimated had cost Barcelona's defenders as many as 18,000 men in four days.

In the world's youngest war, the guerrilla conflict in Mexico, government fliers were reported to have destroyed a rebel airport in San Luis Potosi state in retaliation for aerial attacks on several small towns occupied by federal troops.

### ROOSEVELT TO REVEAL PLAN ON TAX REVISION IN FRIDAY'S ADDRESS

WASHINGTON, May 26.—(AP)—President Roosevelt, the White House said today, will announce his action on the tax revision bill tomorrow during the course of his address at the Arthur Dale, W. Va., resettlement project.

The chief executive has until midnight tomorrow night to make known his decision on whether he has signed or vetoed the bill.

As passed by congress the legislation is designed to ease provisions of the undistributed profits and capital gains levies as aids to business.

### Shell Oil Workers Will Choose Union

WASHINGTON, May 26.—(AP)—The national labor relations board ordered an election today among employees of the Shell Oil company, San Francisco, to determine what union shall represent workers at the company's production, pipeline and refinery departments in bargaining negotiations with the management.

The Shell oil workers will be divided into five groups for the election and given an opportunity to determine whether they want to be represented by the Oil Workers International union (CIO) or by the A.F.L. unions covering machinists, electrical workers, blacksmiths, and boiler-makers.

### Sit-Downers Stay In Gallery Lobby

VANCOUVER, May 26.—(AP)—Seven hundred single unemployed continued to occupy the ground floor lobbies at two downtown buildings today, but 100 of their fellows were in jail, charged with obstructing police by begging on city streets.

Two groups in the central post office and civic art gallery passed their 132nd hour of occupation at 3 a. m. P.S.T.

The 100 were arrested late yesterday as they appeared on street corners soliciting funds with cans bearing the words "We want a works program."

### Communists Open Conclave Tonight

NEW YORK, May 26.—(AP)—Halting against the more conservative parties and fascism, members and delegates of the communist party of the United States arrived from all parts of the country today to attend the party's fourth national convention.

The convention will open with a mass meeting singing "The Star-Spangled Banner" and the "International" in Madison Square garden tonight and continue through Tuesday.

### DR. BAXTER WILL GIVE ADDRESS AT GRADUATION HERE

President of Willamette University to Feature Friday Evening Exercises at Senior High School.

Dr. Bruce R. Baxter, president of Willamette university at Salem, will give the address at commencement exercises Friday evening in the school auditorium to the largest graduating class in Medford senior high school history. The program starts at 8:00 o'clock.

Between 201 and 207 seniors will receive their diplomas following completion of four years of high school studies. The exact number won't be definitely known until tomorrow, when the complete list will be revealed. Until this year, the largest class was in 1937, when 183 students were graduated.

The Rev. Joseph Knotta, pastor of the First Methodist Episcopal church of Medford, will give the invocation and benediction. Included on the program will be three musical numbers, a trumpet solo by Ted Marshall, and a girls' and boys' vocal ensemble.

Because of the limited seating capacity of the auditorium, which has been increased from 1000 to 1185 for the occasion, admittance to the exercises will be by reserved seat ticket only. The graduating seniors have been given tickets for distribution among their friends and relatives. Tomorrow will be the final day of school for nearly 3000 grade, junior and senior high school students and 100 teachers, who will lay away their books for the three-month summer vacation.
