Lunch Scheduled - Lords of the forest of the Crater club will hold a luncheon-meeting in the Hotel Jackson at noon Monday.

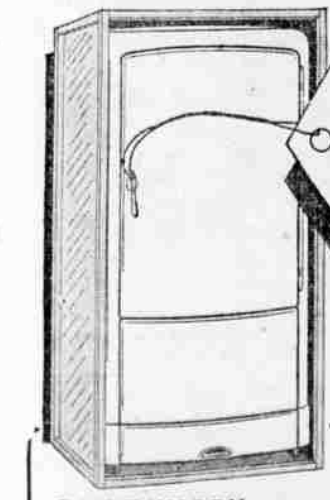

CHICAGO, June 3.—(AP)—A young Negro whose hands and clothing were flecked with fresh blood when he was arrested has confessed slaying four women and a young girl, police investigators said today.
