GENERAL GRUNERT TO NEW COMMAND

WASHINGTON, June 3.—(AP)—The War Department today transferred Brig. Gen. George Grunert from the Philippines to command of the Fifth Infantry brigade, Vancouver Barracks, Wash.

Grunert, now commander of the 23rd brigade at Manila, will succeed Brig. Gen. George C. Marshall, who has been ordered to duty here.

Brig. Gen. Duncan K. Mayor, now at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, who had been scheduled to succeed Brig. Gen. Laurence Halstead at Fort Wardworth, N. Y., was assigned instead to command of the San Francisco port of embarkation, where he will succeed Brig. Gen. Robert S. Abernathy, who will retire this summer.

Col. Irving J. Phillipson was transferred from the 30th Infantry, San Francisco, to command of the Second Infantry brigade, Fort Ontario, N. Y., effective July 1.

Phillipson soon will be advanced to the rank of brigadier general.

Find Flood Victim LOS ANGELES, June 3.—(AP)—A work progress administration steam shovel crew working in the Los Angeles river bed in the Van Nuys district, unearthed today the body of a woman about 35 years old. Police Capt. Bert Massey, who took charge of efforts to identify the woman, said she apparently was a victim of the March 2 flood. He said 15 bodies have been recovered in this district.
