BRITISH YARDS BUILD ARGENTINE WARSHIPS

BARROW-IN-FURNESS, Eng. (UP)—A training cruiser and three destroyers which are being built here for the Argentine government are nearing completion. The training cruiser La Argentina has left Barrow for Birkenhead for dry docking, preparatory to undergoing sea trials. This ship which was built by Vickers Armstrong Ltd., was launched on March 29, 1937. It carries a total complement of 600 officers and men, with special arrangements for training of cadets. It is 510 feet long, and has an extreme breadth of 56 feet, 6 inches. Displacement is 6,500 tons and it is expected to develop 30 knots speed.
