Many upsets may be expected in vote standings during the next few weeks. The contest manager states that the race is far from won at this time as many dark horses probably will develop as the finals draw near. No doubt many candidates are holding votes and no one can predict what will happen in the final rush of vote-getting. Saturday, June 25, will be visiting day at contest headquarters. Main and Bartlett, at which time persons, adults only, may register for their favorite candidate. Each person may register his name, address and name of the candidate he is supporting. For each registration, the candidate will be credited with 200 votes which count on the final prizes only, and not on a bicycle. Registering may take place from 9:30 a. m. until 5:30 p. m. During the day there will be a Golden West coffee and Durkin's mayonnaise demonstration at which time orders for Golden West coffee will be taken.
