

# FOREST WORKMAN RUSHED TO KNIFE

Merl Houston, 30, of Canyonville, underwent an emergency operation in Community hospital this afternoon after his appendix had ruptured. The attending surgeon said it was too early to venture an opinion on his chance for recovery.

Houston was employed in a Rogus River national forest road maintenance crew on Elk creek six miles off the Crater Lake highway. He became ill yesterday morning but worked all day, the forest service said. This

morning, however, his condition had become so serious he was unable to work. A Peri ambulance was sent for Houston this morning. W. L. Jones, forest construction superintendent going out in the ambulance. When the patient reached the hospital his appendix had already ruptured, the surgeon stated.

Mr. Houston's parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Houston of Central Point, were brought to the hospital this afternoon by Mr. Jones.
