

# DIVORCEE CLOSES LOVE STRIKE WITH FEAST ON CHICKEN

Nine-Day Self-Imprisonment in Home of Chubby Manufacturer Ends in Grand Manner — All Is Merry

IRVINGTON, N. Y., June 30.—(AP)—Mrs. Hedi Heusser, the red-haired Hungarian love striker, broke her nine-day self-imprisonment in the Rollo K. Blanchard mansion today. She went to the White Plains office of her attorney, Mortimer O'Brien. It was an unexpected break in the routine she has followed since she took up residence in Blanchard's home with the avowed intention of not leaving until he married her. Blanchard, 48-year-old chubby and bald manufacturer, was not in sight when Mrs. Heusser, his junior by 20 years, emerged from her retreat.

**Dresses for Camera**  
She tried on four or five different hats to get the best pictorial effect for the photographers, and donned lounging pajamas over her dress to give other photographers one more chance to photograph her at her second-story window. Then she emerged, her face all smiles. Last night Mrs. Heusser entertained in the grand manner for the two male detectives and three women guards, assigned to the house by Blanchard.

There was chicken, cooked by herself in the Hungarian style. There were drinks and a re-entertainment by one of the women and a detective of a newspaper account of a promoter's interview in the rain yesterday with Mrs. Heusser.

**All Very Merry**  
The red-haired Mrs. Heusser lived it. Sometimes she halted the mimicry to correct the woman guard's accent. It was all very, very merry. But when she went to bed at last she apparently was still determined to continue her strike until Blanchard arrived to claim her as his bride. There was no hint earlier today that she was to depart so abruptly. Mrs. Heusser, divorced from a Swiss, has two children.

**Huge Sum Received On Job Insurance**  
SALEM, June 30.—(AP)—Distribution of jobless insurance to Oregon's covered unemployment now exceeds \$3,800,000, officials of the state unemployment compensation commission declared today. Approximately 336,000 checks have been issued for an average of \$11.60 per check. The commission has handled 73,102 original claims, of which 300 were for workers now living here who acquired their benefit rights in other states. Their claims are cared for under a reciprocal agreement.
