SUSTAIN CONVICTIONS ON GAS PRICE FIXING

MADISON, Wis., July 20.—(AP)—Federal Judge Patrick T. Stone Tuesday sustained the conviction of 17 of 46 defendants found guilty last January of a conspiracy to raise and fix midwestern gasoline prices in 1935 and 1936. He fined these defendants—12 companies and five executives—a total of \$65,000.

The judge dismissed the charges as to 10 other executives and one corporation and found that the remaining defendants—15 officials and three firms—were entitled to a new trial because they had been linked to the alleged conspiracy only by circumstantial evidence.
