

CITIES OF COAST ENJOYED UPTURN IN JULY BUILDING

Ten Largest Centers Report Over Twelve Billion Represented in Permits for New Construction.

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 5.—(AP)—Builders took out permits for roundly \$12,159,000 worth of new structures in the Pacific coast's 10 largest cities in July, the Associated Press monthly survey showed today.

This substantial figure showed increases over both the preceding month and the like 1937 month. Residential building hit a new high since 1930.

July was the first month to show a gain over the like month of last year since February.

Contra-Season Gain
Most significant in the eyes of business observers, and most encouraging to those who count the building industry virtually equal with agriculture in determining general business trends on the coast, was the July gain over June. This was a contra-seasonal gain. Ordinarily there is a drop in new permit issuances of about 13 per cent from June to July, records indicated when traced by the federal reserve bank of San Francisco over a period of years.

The actual gain of 2.4 per cent over June, added to the expected drop of 13 per cent over what the preceding month had indicated would be realized.

Permits issued in Los Angeles, San Francisco, Seattle, Portland, San Diego, Oakland, Long Beach, Sacramento, Spokane and Tacoma ranked the cities in that order for the month, measured by dollar value.

Seattle Forges Up
Seattle went up to third from 9th place, its jump being attributed to the \$1,000,000 Madison Park housing project, which with other permits gave the city \$1,477,425 in the month's aggregate. Portland climbed to 4th from 8th place, and San Diego held onto fifth place as the gains of the northwest cities forced Oakland down to sixth and Long Beach to 7th. Los Angeles and San Francisco held their customary posts, Nos. 1 and 2, respectively.

The total number of July permits—6894—was lower than the 7497 of June, but up about 300 from July last year and 200 from July, 1936. For the 7 months, the 47,796 permits tallied by a narrow margin of equalling the 48,143 of 1937.

UNION, TURKEY MEN SEEK UNDERSTANDING

PORTLAND, Aug. 5.—(AP)—Representatives of the A.P.L. Meat Cutters' union and the turkey industry discussed working conditions and wages for commercial plants yesterday without taking definite action.

A committee of turkey men will return August 25 with authority to enter an agreement, said J. D. McDonald, union secretary.

McDonald said Oregon turkeys were held up by the union in San Francisco last year. The union released them with the understanding a settlement would be reached for the 1938 season.

THE DALLES, Aug. 5.—(AP)—Two Wasco county cherry cooperatives have started stemming and pitting 39,000 barrels of cherries, an operation which will extend to the 1939 harvest. The Dalles cooperative employed 161 women and the Columbia Fruit Growers 110.
