REIGN OVER HOUSE RULES COMMITTEE STAKE IN BATTLE

Administration Control of Strategic Group Behind Roosevelt Fight Against O'Connor of New York

By JOHN M. HIGHTOWER WASHINGTON, Aug. 18.—(AP)—Administration control of the strategic house rules committee is at stake in President Roosevelt's fight to unseat Rep. John O'Connor of New York.

O'Connor is chairman. Nine other Democrats and four Republicans are members. Four of the Democrats—Sabbath of Illinois, Greenwood of Indiana, Hartman of Ohio and Lewis of Colorado—are generally considered Roosevelt supporters.

Other Demos In Driver opposed the wage-hour bill. Assuming the number of Democratic committee members remains the same in the next session, his defeat will give the administration leadership in the house an opportunity to put a new deal supporter into his place.

Such a situation would place the White House in a highly disadvantageous position for pushing legislation through congress.

Wage Is Reduced For Spud Pickers KLAMATH FALLS, Aug. 18.—(AP)—The Klamath and Tule Lake Potato Growers association, meeting at Hanley, recommended as standard a wage of two cents per 60-pound sack or 40 cents an hour for potato pickers this year.

The rate is a reduction from wages in effect since 1935, when five cents was paid for 120-pound sacks. Lower prices were blamed for the cut.
