KILLER SINGS IN ELECTRIC CHAIR

HUNTSVILLE, Tex., Aug. 19.—(UP)—Jesse Polanco, a San Antonio Mexican youth, and Colman H. Morgan of El Paso died in the electric chair at the Texas state penitentiary early today. Polanco was executed for the murder of George Forbis, a bus driver during a holdup. He died while singing "The Sweetest Girl in San Antonio." Polanco was placed in the chair at 12:16 a. m. C. S. T. and was pronounced dead at 12:22.

Morgan, who killed his wife, Eleanor Rose Morgan, died first. He entered the death chamber shortly after midnight and refused any comment other than a sullen "No" to Warden W. W. Wald's question if he had any last words.

HITLER HAIL BARS DAD FROM VISITING SONS

CHICAGO, Aug. 19.—(UP) Because he allegedly taught his two small sons to greet friends with "Hell Hitler," Irish-born Harry Doherty was denied the right to visit them today. Mrs. Elizabeth Doherty was granted the injunction by Superior Court Judge Peter M. Schwaba after she testified her estranged husband had taught their two sons, Harry, Jr., 10, and Jackie, 7, Nazi German principles. Doherty said he had seen the children only twice in two years and branded the charges as "killy."

BERLIN, Aug. 19.—(AP)—Three Germans were executed at dawn for treason, consisting of entering in "relations with the information service of a foreign power for monetary gain."

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 19.—(UP)—The body of a woman, identified as Mrs. Hope Elizabeth Draper, 44, was found in a trunk at her home here last night. There was an empty bottle which had contained chloroform near the trunk. The discovery was made by her husband, Arthur Draper, a traveling salesman, when he returned home after a business trip.

The coroner's office believed Mrs. Draper had been dead since Monday and that she had taken her own life. Draper's attention was attracted to the trunk because it was not in its usual position. He lifted the lid and found the body, in sitting position with the knees pulled up and the head resting on the hands. Mrs. Muriel Burke and a daughter, 16, had been in the house since Monday, but they believed Mrs. Draper was away on a visit.

PLYMOUTH'S STAR DICK TRACY FILM SHOWING AT ROXY

DETROIT—(Spl.)—It takes a tough automobile to stand up under the grueling action encountered during the filming of a "knock-em-down" detective thriller. The make-believe of a Hollywood movie drama becomes punishing reality as far as the "props" are concerned, and a car has to take a real licking in many sequences. During the filming of Republic's latest thriller "Dick Tracy Returns," opening at the Roxy, Plymouths were used as "G-Men" squad cars in many a break-neck chase before the "villains" are brought to justice. 'UNCLE' WILL BUY SURPLUS PEACHES

WASHINGTON, Aug. 19.—(UP)—The Federal Surplus Commodities corporation announced today it would purchase surplus dried clingstone and freestone peaches in California. The purchase program will begin immediately and continue until June 30, 1939. The peaches will be distributed to needy people through state relief agencies.

The corporation said it would buy from growers, associations of growers or packers through authorized agents. The surplus removal program was necessitated, the corporation said, because the total production of California dried peaches this year will be the largest in several years.
