FREE PICTURE TO GIVE INFORMATION ON HOME BUILDING

A recently-produced sound motion picture, "Today We Build," will be shown by the federal housing administration in the basement auditorium of the Hotel Medford at a p. m. Tuesday.

Anyone interested in home building is invited to see the 43-minute film which is designed to be educational. Expected to be in the audience are city officials, mortgage lenders, realtors, lumbermen, contractors and others directly interested in a home building program...

Featured speakers on the program will be James (Paul Bunyan) Stevens of the West Coast Lumbermen's association, Seattle, Wash., and W. C. Bell of the Western Retail Lumbermen's association.

An informative, statistical talk will also be given by City Councilman George T. Frey, chairman of the land appraisal committee.

Attendance of the public was urged yesterday by the Jackson County Chamber of Commerce, co-sponsor of the film showing here.

"The chamber of commerce has been vitally interested in the federal housing administration since its inception and has initiated various campaigns in connection with it during the past few years," said A. H. Banwell, manager.

"The shortage of homes in Medford lends itself to this type of program. We sincerely hope, therefore, that everyone interested in home building will plan to see this educational picture Tuesday night."

HIGH COURT NOT CAUSE NRA END

PORTLAND, Aug. 20.—(AP)—The supreme court had little to do with the death of the NRA. Dr. Dexter M. Keuser, Reed college president, and consultant on economics of a temporary national economic committee appointed by the federal attorney-general, declared today.

He said the NRA died before the supreme court acted. England, he declared, has proceeded along the same road and has outdone the NRA in every respect.

"Without competition, capitalism is definitely on the way out," Keuser said. "When it is broken down we go into regulation." A national balance, he said, is the problem of the committee.
