VOLTAGE SHOCK USED TO TREAT MENTAL CASES

ROME Oct. 4.-(UP)-Asylums for the insane may be greatly reduced if a system of curing insanity by electric shock, developed by an Italian scientist, proves practical. The Cerletti system, named after its inventor, Prof. Ugo Cerletti, director of the clinic for nervous disorders at the University of Rome, is applicable in schizophrenic types of madness. This is a form of melancholia in which the patient is reduced to long periods of morbidness or hypochondria.

The system is inexpensive, easy to regulate and apply and easy to use without the previous knowledge of the patient-which is a necessary requisite in the cure of insanity by shock. The shock is introduced into the patient through a headpiece much in the form of earphones.

Cerletti has experimented with mental cases and he declares that he is satisfied with the results. He admits that the system is not entirely perfected and that further experiments will have to be conducted before it can be universally applied.

Should the system live up to its inventor's expectations it would be a tremendous contribution to the therapeutic field because it could be applied to an estimated 80 per cent of the inmates of asylums. Dr. Cerletti contends that this percentage of insanity cases are affected by the harmless schizophrenic type of madness.

FOG AND WHALES BESET JUNK UPON PACIFIC VOYAGE

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 5.-(AP)-There was a time, Dr. E. Allen Petersen admitted today, when he and his crew wished they had never started their 85-day crossing of the Pacific in a frail Chinese junk.

Refreshed after the first night in nearly three months spent in a bed which remained horizontal, instead of "bobbing around like a cork," the 37-year old seaman who turned sea captain recalled experiences of his voyage from the Orient to southern California-much of it spent battling whales and fog.

In fact he said, like a true native son, he was off the coast of California before he struck really good weather.

Dr. Petersen, with his bride, Tane, California-born Japanese, consummated a long ambition when he brought the 38-foot junk Hummel-Hummel into San Pedro yesterday with two Russian youths, Nick Permannoff and Victor Ermeloff, as crewmen.

Pog was their biggest problem, the doctor said, far after two sunny days out of Yokohama, they went through a month of murky gloom, seeing neither sun nor stars.

While Petersen and his wife were learning to walk on dry land again, their two Russian crew members were forced to remain on the small craft because they have no passports. Immigration authorities, who refused to let them land, were confronted with the additional problem of where to deport the pair since they maintain they are white Russians and a return to Russia might mean imprisonment or death.
