CRATERS TO PUT ON INITIATIONS, ASHLAND, MONDAY

A public initiatory ceremony by the Crater club will be the star entertainment feature of the Shasta-Cascade Wonderland association convention in Ashland next Monday night. This will be an exclusive tribute to the members and guests of the wonderland organization as the ceremony has never before been revealed

to the general public. Inasmuch as the affair is open to all who care to attend, a large audience is expected. Club members and other citizens of Medford are especially invited by O. O. Alenderfer, big eruption of the club.

PLUM HOLDER IN MARYLAND PURGE ELECTION RAPPED

WASHINGTON, Oct. 7.—(AP)—The senate campaign expenditures committee, disagreeing with Secretary Morgenthau, held today to its contention M. Hampton Magruder, Maryland collector of internal revenue, had been guilty of improper political activity. The committee wrote the treasury secretary he was wrong in approving Magruder's actions during the Maryland Democratic primary campaign and asserted it would request the senate to take action.

Morgenthau had advised the committee he approved Magruder's telling non-civil service employees of his office that, while they were free to vote as they please, he was supporting Rep. David J. Lewis. The senate committee had called Morgenthau's attention to Magruder's action and asserted it violated the spirit, if not the letter, of the civil service act. Lewis, President Roosevelt's choice for the senate nomination last to Sen. Tydings. Describing Magruder's action as "a breach of the treasury department's own regulations" as well as "violative of sound administrative principles," the committee told Morgenthau "no excuse is to be found for it."
