

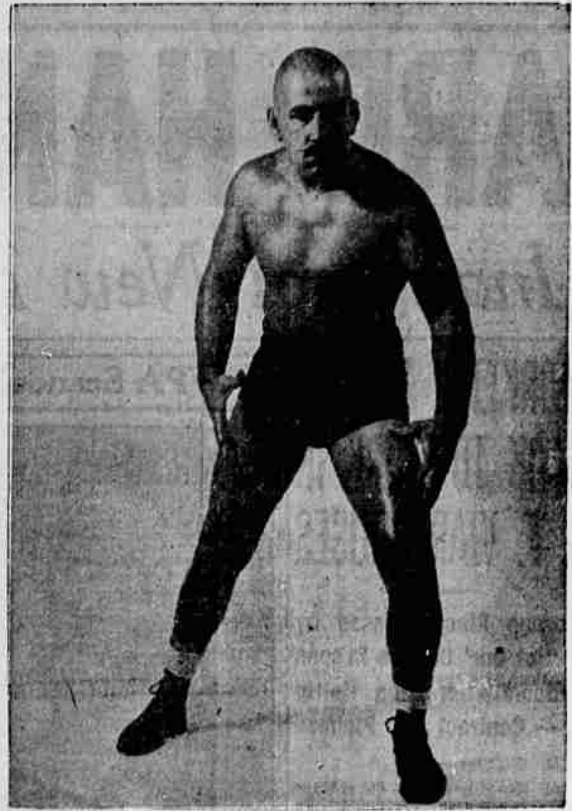
# Bad Boys to Meet Pure Grapplers in Tonight's Armory Program
