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CANDIDATES STAY IN METROPOLITAN AREA FOR WINDUP

Thousands of Words Pour Out As Final Drive Made in Oregon—Sprague Defines Main Issue at Rally

PORTLAND, Nov. 4. — (AP) — Although political observers had already decided how they would ballot at Tuesday's general election, thousands of words flowed from the lips of candidates who watched time run out rapidly in the last days of the campaign.

Candidates for governor and the United States senate and the interstate seeking the success or defeat of measures remained in the Willamette valley, the state's most densely populated section.

Attend Rally
All major Republican nominees appeared at a Marion county party rally last night. Charles A. Sprague, candidate for governor, defined good government as the chief issue.

"This state is going to decide," he said, "whether we shall put into power an administration of left-wing radicals or Commonwealth members with a communistic fringe, of labor racketeer supporters or whether we shall have sound, stable government."

Rufus C. Holman, state treasurer and Republican choice for the senate, warned against national bankruptcy and stated he would work to stabilize money, preserve liberty and freedom and balance the federal budget. Other Republicans at the rally included Earl Snell, secretary of state, Congressman James Mott of the first district, and Charles A. Rice of Portland, candidate for superintendent of public instruction.

Hess Hits Power Firms
"The people of this area paid about \$16,000,000 for power in 1934 while under the publicly controlled power districts sought by the national administration the same power would have cost only \$8,000,000," Henry L. Hess, Democratic nominee for governor, said in an address here.

He proposed changes in the power district laws to prevent "Washington from getting the bulk of Bonneville dam energy."

Willis E. Mahoney, Klamath Falls Democrat making his second successive campaign for the senate, urged his election in a Portland address on the basis it was necessary to have Democratic representation in the upper house to line up the majority's vote for such all-Oregon issues as the Umatilla dam and Willamette valley projects.

"While Senator McNary is lining up Republican votes, Willis Mahoney will line up Democratic votes and working in co-operation will secure the required votes to put over both projects," he said.

Frank Tierney, Democratic state chairman, told the Willamette Democratic society the party "really" was on a parity with Republican voting strength because county clerks had not removed "dead" Republican registrations from the files.
