NEW CAR KEYED TO MODERN TEMPO

PEAR, NUT CROPS IN STATE RECORD

PORTLAND, Nov. 12.—(AP)—Oregon's late fruit and nut season, topped by record walnut and pear crops, was listed "entirely satisfactory" today from the standpoint of production. All crops equalled or exceeded last month's forecasts, with the most favorable changes occurring for walnuts and cranberries. Good yields in eastern Oregon irrigated sections sent the potato harvest above earlier expectations. Reports compiled by the federal bureau of agricultural economics included: Apples: Crop up slightly. Estimates of 4,142,000 bushels compared with 3,900,000 last year and the ten year average of 4,590,000. Pears: Record high established. Estimates of 4,220,000 bushels compared with 3,550,000 a year ago and the ten year average of 2,910,000 bushels.
