

MARKET AGENCY TO AID FARMERS IS RECOMMENDED

Agricultural, Educational and Business Leaders for Plan—May Be Submitted to 1941 Legislature Session

SALEM, Sept. 22.—(AP)—Creation of a statewide marketing agency to help Oregon farmers sell their products was recommended today by agricultural, educational and business leaders at a conference called by the state board of higher education.

Speakers agreed that the University of Oregon and Oregon State college courses in production were adequate, but they recommended that the two schools balance marketing education with that of production.
