

# RAYMOND J. KELLY IS NEW LEADER OF AMERICAN LEGION

## Detroit Lawyer To Succeed Chadwick—Outlawing Of Communist Party And Bunds Asked By Vets.

CHICAGO, Sept. 28.—(AP)—Raymond J. Kelly, corporation counsel of Detroit, was elected national commander of the American Legion today.

Kelly was chosen unanimously to succeed Stephen F. Chadwick, of Seattle, after two other contenders for the office had withdrawn. The new chief of the organization of 1,926,084 ex-service men has been head of Detroit's legal department since 1933. He worked his way through the universities of Notre Dame and Detroit and served 10 months overseas during the world war as a lieutenant in the artillery.

Legislation to outlaw "the communist party, the German bund and similar organizations," was advocated by the American Legion.

Delegates attending the final session of the 21st national convention approved the report of the Americanism committee urging such action.

The Legionnaires also called upon congress to enact legislation "to eliminate all profits from war" as a move to safeguard the nation's peace.

The demand for universal service in war time was supported unanimously when presented by the committee on legislation.

The organization opposed any change in the method of declaring war in the United States—an action aimed at proposals to put the question of war or peace into the hands of the citizens in a referendum.

Members endorsed another resolution which expressed opposition to "further efforts" to change the traditional date of Thanksgiving lest the feast be "too close" to Armistice day.

## ONE MAN IS MASTER OF NOISES INSERTED IN MOTION PICTURES

HOLLYWOOD (UP)—Motion picture audiences do not realize it, but all the sounds they hear on the screen are not incorporated into the scene at the time it is filmed.

Much of the sound is added later and a man named Jack Chapin is the sound effects man, the many-voiced, multi-noised fellow who does the work of adding sounds.

You've seen shots where a sleeper is awakened in the night by footsteps outside. That's Chapin. You've heard eerie sounds, stumbles, falls, muttered voices, squawks from radios, automobile motors—the list goes on indefinitely—as off-stage noises. That's still Chapin.

Sometimes he gets in a picture playing a bit part, for he is a competent comedian. But for the most part he's a series of off-stage noises.

"Sometimes," says Chapin, "a player will miff a line. Maybe it's an important line. In order to get it recorded right, they would have to do the scene over again, call in the players and extras and go to a lot of expense. Perhaps the players are scattered to other studios and other pictures. In those cases I study the voice needed, say the line in approximately the player's tones and it's inserted."

## RED CROSS CALLS FOR AID TO CLOTHE REFUGEES OF WAR

### War Relief Production Committee Formed For Jackson County—Clothing, Hospital Supplies Needed

A meeting was held this morning in the Red Cross office at the county courthouse for formation of a war relief production committee in Jackson county. The session was called by Mrs. Alfred S. V. Carpenter, chairman.

Thirty attended to constitute committee heads in response to an appeal from the national headquarters of the American Red Cross for clothing to be used for war refugees and hospital supplies for war victims. An immediate appeal is being made in Jackson county for material to be made into clothing for refugee men, women and children.

Mrs. Alex Sparrow, material chairman, voiced a call for the following new goods: percale, gingham, flannel, challis and broadcloth. Persons able to supply the materials are asked to contact either the Red Cross office or Mrs. Sparrow at once.

Start At Once  
Work will start now and progress as soon as materials are on hand at the Red Cross office until other places are made available.

Work has also been received from national headquarters to maintain the traditional policy of the Red Cross in extending aid impartially to all victims of all wars from whom an appeal is made. So far aid has been asked from Poland, England and France.
