

EMPLOYMENT AID GIVEN 3587 SINCE START OF YEAR

Response of local employers to the program of the Oregon State Em-

ployment Service is shown in a report of activities of the local office just released. It was indicated that the local office had made 3,587 job placements with over 800 different employers up to October 1 of the current year, an increase of 920 successful job placements over the total for the complete year of 1938. Occupations included in the placements varied from various kinds of common labor and domestics, to clerks, stenographers, mechanics, machine operators, salesmen, and professional types. Several draftsmen were recently placed through the lo-

cal office at salaries ranging from \$1,800 to \$2,000 per year. One engineer was also placed in a position paying \$4,000 per year to start. Largest single class of placements represented were the 2,667 jobs in agricultural occupations listed through the local employment office up to October 1. Although this figure represents a 2,000 increase over the 1938 total for the year, plans are already under way to extend this farm placement activity next year. John Cooter, farm placement supervisor for the Oregon State Employment Service, was a recent visitor in Medford and

Grants Pass where he conferred with local farm groups regarding their seasonal employment program. Arrangements have been made to establish a field office for the particular service of hop growers in 1940. The Farm Security Administration has also indicated its willingness to cooperate by planning to establish a temporary transient camp for families in the hop yards during the 1940 season. GUARD FONDA HOME WHEN KIDNAP PLANS OVERHEARD BY GIRL

HOLLYWOOD, Oct. 10. — (AP) — Guards watched Actor Henry Fonda's home today as police disclosed a week's secret investigation into re-

ports of a kidnap plot. Mentioned as possible victims were the actor himself, the two-year-old daughter of Fonda and his socially prominent wife, and Mrs. Fonda's eight-year-old daughter by a former marriage. Pauline La Hue, 18-year-old daughter of a real estate man in San Bernardino, 60 miles east of here, told officers she overheard a street corner conversation, in which one of the men remarked, "It'll be the biggest thing Hollywood ever heard of." She said the other replied: "Well, if we can't snatch one of

the kids, what is the matter with Fonda, himself," then, noticing her, growled, "shut up, we've got company." The girl added that a few hours later, at her home, a male voice asked her over the telephone: "Is this the blonde?" then went on to warn her: "If you want to remain as you are, you had better stop listening to conversations on street corners."
