African Chieftain Orders 'Razzberry' For Adolf Hitler

LONDON, Oct. 13.—(AP)—The Omahene of Akwapim, chief of an African Gold Coast tribe, has announced a judgment of "three hootings" against Adolf Hitler, the ministry of information said today.

A ministry communique stated: "After the Omahene had stated the case of Great Britain and Germany all the linguists rose up and went into consultation and on their return the chief linguist gave judgment... three cheers for the king and three hootings against Hitler, whose case was bad."

Gov. Olson Eager To Free Billings

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 13.—(AP)—Governor Gilbert L. Olson wrote to the California supreme court today urging the court make a recommendation which would permit him to grant a pardon to Warren K. Billings, serving a life term at Folsom prison for the 1916 Preparedness day bombing.

Governor Olson's first official act in office was the granting of a full pardon to Tom Mooney, also convicted of the bombing.

He has repeatedly stated his belief in the innocence of both Mooney and Billings, who always insisted they were "railroaded" to prison for the bombing by elements opposed to their labor-leading activities.

Blocking an outright pardon for Billings, however, is the state law which says a governor may not pardon a man with a prior criminal record without the approval of the state supreme court.

BRITISH SPORTS TURNED TO AID ARMED FORCES

LONDON.—(UP)—Sports are at a standstill throughout the British Isles.

Here and there are heard suggestions that they may be resumed in one form or another, but with England's leading football and tennis players, boxers, golfers and jockeys already in khaki and a government ban in effect against events of a crowd-drawing nature the chances are negligible.

The English turf has been hard hit by the war. There are indications that all sections will suffer heavily. Most Newmarket trainers are keeping their first-class horses only, and either taking medium class mounts out of training or selling them to the government for remounts, while moderate horses are simply being given away.

Recently a number of prominent Irish bookmakers met in Dublin and discussed the possibility of holding the most important English races in Eire, but even this was considered unlikely in view of transportation difficulties.

Official quarters consider competitive football at present out of the question. Likewise any scheme to exploit the game for money-making purposes was regarded as objectionable.
