

JURY FOR DAHACK EXPECTED TODAY

Yesterday was a legal holiday, delaying selection of a justice court jury to hear the trial tomorrow morning of Edgar Dahack, 19, Eagle Point high school student charged with assault and battery in a complaint signed by C. R. Davis, principal. It was expected to be drawn today. Attorney William M. McAllister has been retained as defense counsel.

Dahack during an argument over his absence from school for three days is alleged to have struck the principal, causing discoloration of an optic.

Lumber Business Dwindles in Week

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 13.—(AP)—Reports from 117 mills showed last week's new business of \$6,331,000, less than the previous week, the Western Pine association said today. Shipment of \$4,300,000 feet represented a decline of about four million. Production was virtually unchanged at 80,294,000 feet. Orders, shipments and production were considerably ahead of the corresponding week a year ago.

SUBMARINES SEEN IN CARIBBEAN AREA

WASHINGTON, Oct. 13.—(AP)—Rep. Snyder (D-Pa.) returned from an inspection of Caribbean fortifications today with a story of extensive foreign submarine operations near United States soil.

Snyder, chairman of the house military appropriations sub-committee, said Governor Lawrence Cramer of the Virgin Islands had expressed the opinion to him that a flotilla of foreign submarines had been in the Caribbean since early August.

Cramer did not name the nationality of the undersea craft, Snyder said, adding there was belief in the island that they belonged "to a power embittered against British shipping."

Canadian Steamer Grounded in Fog

VANCOUVER, B. C., Oct. 13.—(CP)—Canadian Pacific Steamship officials said last night their coastal vessel, Princess Adelaide went ashore near Port McNeill, 200 miles north of Victoria on the east coast of Vancouver island, but was not in danger. A salvage vessel left Victoria for the scene but it will take the boat 24 hours to reach Port McNeill.

The Adelaide, which struck about one-half mile from the port in a fog, is carrying a "few passengers," officials said.

PEAR HARVESTING OVER NEXT WEEK

Harvesting of the 1939 pear crop will not be completed for another week, as it will take that long to pick the remaining Winter Nellis and Newtown apples. Some packing plants have already finished, and all will be done by the end of next week.

Some fall plowing is underway, but seeding has not started to any extent. Most farmers are waiting for a rain. Cows are being gathered, and used extensively in fattening turkeys. The onion crop figured at double last year has been dug. Harry Dunn of the Central Point district had a good crop, now in storage.
