

G. B. S. FOR PRESIDENT OF EUROPEAN STATES, PROPOSED FOR PEACE

Eugene, Ore., Oct. 19.—(AP)—As a solution of European ills George Bernard Shaw, whom he hails as the "fixit citizen" of Europe, was today proposed as president of a United Europe by S. Stephenson Smith, educational counsellor for the American

Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers, in a radio address. Such a step would be the most logical way to end the present war, and end all wars, Professor Smith declared. Although he cheerfully admitted the futility of his suggestion, Professor Smith, a popular English faculty member of the University of Oregon on leave of absence for a lecture tour, maintains his reasons are sound and for the most part sensible. "There would be no question in Shaw's mind of his own pre-eminence fitness for the job," Smith declared. Others too

will admit he is the only private person in Europe to make his voice heard above those of the dictators and premiers. Mussolini has a high regard for him. As a professional agitator for 60 years Shaw can out-talk Hitler. He can bargain with Stalin on even terms, if the agonized howls of theatrical managers who have had dealings with him can be believed. EX-APPELLATE MAN HAS NARROW ESCAPE IN ALASKA WATERS

Big Applegate, Oct. 19.—(Spl.)—Emmett Phillips, former Applegate resident, escaped possible death in the wrecking of fishing boats off the Alaskan coast late in September, according to news received by Mr. Phillips' parents, Mr. and Mrs.

Raymond Phillips, who reside at Squaw Lake. Young Phillips was skipper of the "Chickadee," one of three fishing boats lost during an 80-mile gale lashing the Sitka coast and Lazareff Island vicinity September 22. A fourth ship plying the waters at the time reached safety. One of five men on the boats was killed. Phillips boarded another boat and escaped injuries, although the "Chickadee," which he skippered, was sunk in about 30 feet of water, and was wrecked beyond salvaging. Phillips lost all of his possessions with the

exception of the clothing he wore. Phillips, who had been connected with the Alaskan fishing industry for several years, and who had been at Fort Alexander all summer, wrote his parents that now he expects to spend the winter trapping, and will purchase another boat in the spring. He fished principally for King salmon which weigh around 22 pounds, and reach top prices in the market. Logger Crushed to Death. Walla Walla, Wash., Oct. 19. (AP)—Cecil C. Howard, Walla Walla, who crawled onto a truck

load of logs yesterday to loosen a jammed log, was crushed to death when the entire load, unloosened by his tugs on the chain, rolled over on him. It was his third day on the job. The accident occurred near Heppner, Ore. Weather.
