

# Rose Bowl Spotlight Swings From Webfoots to Beavers

That misfortune at Eugene Saturday didn't eliminate the University of Oregon from the Rose Bowl ballot because the game wasn't in the Pacific coast conference, but it swung the spotlight from the Webfoots to the Oregon State college Beavers. The Orangemen, who looked too shaky after bad showings against Idaho and Portland U. to be mentioned in the same breath with the Rose Bowl, appeared the northwest's chief hope this week.

Beating the University of Washington scarcely puts the Orange in a class by itself but it's more of a feat than the records would lead you to believe. The Huskies have displayed plenty of power and passing finesse right along and only their goal line ineptness

kept them from winning. Against Washington the Beavers acquitted themselves with honors, got over a dangerous hump of the schedule without injury and took undisputed conference leadership. If this October Rose Bowl talk must continue, it'll center around the Corvallis team for awhile.

**Disregard Zag Win**  
Oregon's loss to the Zags is being glibly disregarded so far as the Pasadena prospect goes but it may turn out to be damaging. Prestige is a precious commodity when the post-season team is picked, particularly in cases of a conference championship tie, which is not unlikely this year. A loss to Gonzaga is no help to a conference team's prestige.

They can lift themselves back into the beam next Saturday if they can flop UCLA at Los Angeles, a job that looks tougher by the hour. But then the Ducks seem to be keyed to the tough ones this year.
