

JOHN L. STAFFORD, VETERAN, PASSES AFTER LONG ILL

John LeMoine Stafford, 53, a resident of Medford for the past six years, passed away at a local hospital at 8 a. m. Wednesday, after a prolonged illness. Mr. Stafford was born in Chicago, February 16, 1886.

He spent his early life and gained his education in Chicago, and when the World war was declared he enlisted at Fort George Wright, Washington, July 12, 1918, being honorably discharged July 30, 1919. He was supply sergeant with headquarters company, 14th infantry. After the Armistice he came to Portland, Ore., and was united in marriage to Miss Eloise M. Imah, January 20, 1921. They came to Medford in 1923. He was a charter member of the Portland post, American Legion and transferred to Medford post No. 15. He was a life member of the American Trappers association and a member of the Portland Gun club.

Mr. Stafford was considered one of the best manufacturers of pickles in the northwest, and was northern manager of the California Conserving company for many years.

He leaves to mourn his departure his wife, two sons, Colby Theodore Stafford, Chicago, and John LeMoine Stafford, Jr., Medford; three sisters, Mrs. Jewel V. Poorman, Kansas City, Mo.; Mrs. Addie S. Wright, Chicago; Mrs. LeMoine S. Kelley, Lake Forest, Ill.; one brother, Frank Stafford, Libertyville, Ill.; one grandson, Colby Stafford, Jr., Chicago.

Funeral services will be conducted from Perl Funeral Home Friday at 2 p. m., Rev. Dr. Sherman L. Divine, pastor of the First Presbyterian church, officiating. Interment will be in Skidway Memorial park.

Medford Post No. 15 American Legion will have charge of services at the graveside, and will act as pallbearers. Company "A" Medford National Guard will fire a final salute over his grave, and taps will be sounded.

ITALIAN-GREEK PACT HELD NEW EVIDENCE DUCE'S PEACE AIMS

Rome, Nov. 2.—(AP)—Athens dispatches reporting an Italian-Greek peace agreement were regarded in diplomatic circles today as fresh evidence of Premier Mussolini's leadership in efforts to keep war out of the Balkans.

(The Greek government announced an exchange of letters with Italy "contributing to the preservation of peace in this part of Europe.")

Nothing has been disclosed here concerning the Italian-Greek negotiations, but diplomats heard two days ago that the two states were about to sign a non-aggression pact.

Foreign circles pointed out that Italy now is on good terms with the Balkan countries which lie within Rome's sphere of influence. These sources considered her relations with Turkey satisfactory, although Italy was not considered likely to sign an agreement with that power since it might give the appearance that Mussolini was lining up with Britain and France, with whom Turkey signed a mutual aid pact October 19.

Not only Italy, but the Mediterranean area of Europe from Spain to Turkey was spared war, in view of many observers, because of Mussolini's choice of a non-belligerent status for his country.

MARTIAL LAW DECREED BY THE NETHERLANDS AS DEFENSE MEASURE

The Hague, The Netherlands, Nov. 2.—(AP)—A martial law decree embracing every strategic point on land or water in The Netherlands gave the nation's high command authority today to exercise supreme powers if Holland is caught in the northern pincers of the European war.

Covering parts of eight provinces, or all but three in the northeast—Groningen, Drenthe and Overijssel—the order affects approximately half of the German-Netherlands frontier. It also applies to centers for flood defense, to virtually all North Sea territorial waters and islands, and to the long dyke which locks the northern end of the Zuider Zee.

In general, the regions named in the decree already are occupied by troops.

Official sources said the decision was not due to a fear of invasion, but designed to facilitate defenses, including a flood line upon which the nation depends to prevent war from spreading to its rich and populous western sections.

RECORDER CLAIMS BOOKS IN ORDER

Salem, Nov. 2.—(AP)—City Recorder A. Warren Jones said "there is nothing wrong with my affairs as city recorder," when he returned last night from San Francisco to answer a report from Lester W. Barr, auditor retained by the city council, that the official books failed to account for \$4,081.39.

Jones said he would make a further statement after making "a complete check of all details."

Dist. Attorney Lyle J. Page ordered a grand jury investigation after the council requested him to take "appropriate action."
