

SHASTA DAM ROAD BIDS ARE OPENED

Sacramento, Cal., Nov. 24.—(AP)—Granfield, Farrar and Carlin, San Francisco, today submitted a low bid of \$326,966 for grading and surfacing 4.1 miles of highway between the top of Bass hill and O'Brien summit and construction of a 375-foot viaduct on the relocation of U. S. highway 99 around Shasta dam in Shasta county. The project is a portion of 15.35 miles of highway relocation necessary because the present highway will be flooded by the reservoir to be formed when Shasta dam is completed in 1943.

Boy's Spleen Broken In "Touch" Football

Eugene, Nov. 24.—(AP)—Paul Ekleman, Portland University of Oregon freshman, is critically ill in a local hospital following an injury sustained in an interfraternity "touch" football game. The youth's spleen was ruptured and was removed in an operation. After several blood transfusions attendants said today he will probably recover.

HOLLYWOOD SLAYING TERMED GANG ACTION

Hollywood, Cal., Nov. 24.—(AP)—George Schachter, 48, a clothing dealer, was shot to death in front of his home last night in what police said was apparently a gangland killing. Two men in a black sedan without license plates drew up beside Schachter's automobile, as the victim arrived at his house late yesterday, and shot him three times in the mouth, cheek and throat.

ALASKA FLIER KILLED LANDING IN SNOWSTORM

Fairbanks, Alaska, Nov. 24.—(AP)—Blinded by a snowstorm and apparently thinking he was over the Fairbanks airport, Pilot Morris Johnson, one of Alaska's leading commercial fliers, landed his plane in a brushy area, a half mile south of the airport late yesterday. His plane was wrecked and he was killed in the wreckage. He was flying without passengers on a return trip from Jack Wade creek.

SWISS RAID OFFICES OF PRO-NAZI PAPER

Basel, Switzerland, Nov. 24.—(AP)—Swiss anti-propaganda police today raided the offices of the Neue Basler Zeitung, a pro-Nazi newspaper which has a large circulation in Germany and almost none in Switzerland. Authorities said a number of documents were seized.
