DUCK DEATHS Startling revelation by the U. S. Bureau of Biological Survey shows vast fatalities from lead poisoning among wild fowl, as a result of eating discharged lead shot in the bottoms of marshes.

TO remove this menace to wild life, Drs. R. L. Dowdell and R. G. Green, of the University of Minnesota Institute of Technology, developed a formula for duck shot composed of 99 percent lead and 1 percent magnesium, costing no more than ordinary shot.
